

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA (GDPR) – Notice (Hereinafter referred to as the “Notice”)

The processing of personal data is carried out in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter referred to as the “GDPR”) and with Act No. 18/2018 Coll. on the protection of personal data and on amending and supplementing certain acts.

In this notice, we provide you, as the data subject, with information on how we process your data in connection with the sale of tickets on the website www.salonprive.sk.

1. IDENTIFICATION OF THE CONTROLLER

The controller who determines the purposes and means of processing your personal data is:

2. SCOPE OF PROCESSED DATA

- 1) We only process data necessary to ensure your participation in the event:
- 2) Identification data: Name and surname (due to the non-transferability of the ticket), date of birth (verification of age 18+).
- 3) Contact data: E-mail address, telephone number, delivery address (for sending physical tickets).
- 4) Payment details: Bank account number (for matching payment or refund in case of cancellation of the event).

3. PURPOSE AND LEGAL BASIS OF PROCESSING

We process your data for the following purposes:

- 1) Performance of the contract (Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR): Ticket reservation, issuing an advance invoice, delivery of the ticket and identity verification upon entry to the event.
- 2) Compliance with legal obligations (Art. 6(1)(c) GDPR): Obligations arising from the Accounting Act and tax regulations.
- 3) Legitimate interest (Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR): Protection of the organizer's property and safety (verification of the participant's age and identity upon entry).

4. DATA RETENTION PERIOD

- 1) 1) We retain data related to the performance of the contract for the period necessary for the implementation of the event.
- 2) 2) We retain accounting documents (invoices) in accordance with the law for a period of 10 years.
- 3) 3) Data processed for the purpose of verifying identity upon entry are not further archived beyond the scope necessary for the inspection on the day of the event.

5. RECIPIENTS OF PERSONAL DATA

- 1) We do not sell your data to third parties. Only the following may have access to it:
Courier/postal service providers (for the purpose of delivering tickets).
Accounting service provider (invoicing processing).
Competent state authorities (in the event of an inspection).

6. YOUR RIGHTS AS A DATA SUBJECT

- 1) As a data subject, you have the right to:
 - Request access to your personal data.
 - To correct incorrect or incomplete data.
 - To delete data (the so-called "right to be forgotten") if they are no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected.
 - To restrict processing.
 - To file a complaint with the Slovak Personal Data Protection Office (<https://dataprotection.gov.sk>).

7. AUTOMATED DECISION-MAKING AND TRANSFER TO THIRD COUNTRIES

- 1) The operator does not carry out automated individual decision-making or profiling. Your personal data are not transferred to third countries outside the EU or the European Economic Area.

8. OBLIGATION TO PROVIDE DATA

- 1) The provision of personal data is a contractual requirement. Without providing name, email and address, it is not possible to issue a non-transferable ticket and deliver it to the Participant.
